My current role requires me to work with a broad range of technologies across 2 international teams. I was taken on as an Elasticsearch SME , initially to secure their existing clusters, and going forward to manage its upgrade. I've recently been involved in developing some new strategies to tune their use of data in Elastic to optimise the performance of their solutions, along with extending usage across the stack. I'm currently looking at opportunities within the AWS cloud architecture to increase both failover capabilities and extensibility by employing some strategies I made use of in my role in the BBC.

Alongside my Elasticsearch work , I'm also involved across the teams , working with the Java spring boot server side solutions, and extending my reach into their client side technologies. As it stands I have also been using my skills to support their current set of requirements that relate to monitoring and performance, setting up dashboards and metrics that allow the team to analyse the current application stack status at a glance.

Responsible for maintenance and extension of both the home and Motor web quote and buy products. Both products were built on Java 8, Spring boot applications, with an Oracle / hibernate persistence layer, as well as making use of a redis stack as a state management solution. Both products also used a mix of front end Javascript technologies, including React, JQuery and a number of node libraries. I was heading a small team with an existing backlog of technical debt and product improvement tickets. I was brought in to help involve the dev teams with our extended dev ops team, and help integrate the two areas more closely. This involved both the CI layer using Jenkins and AWS to host and extended our capabilities across multiple environments. Integration of these technologies included development of a number of bash utility scripts to facilitate the CI pipeline. We used a combination of Elasticsearch, Logstash and Kibana to monitor our logs across our environments, along with Cloud watch to monitor our applications. Our code deployments, that are driven but custom built jenkins jobs, are also facilitated by AWS Lambdas that allow our binaries to be moved from s3 to nexus, or other s3 buckets on receipt of the completed build pipelines

I was also heavily involved in architecting a new internal colleague tool, that needed to be integrated into an existing dashboard solution. The intention for this was to develop an isomorphic Javascript solution using Node on the server side and React for the client side, to allow this fall into line with the company's current technical direction.

In line with my position as a Senior developer, my responsibilities also extended to coaching junior developers when they joined the team. I took them through our working practises and code bases to allow them to get up to speed, and then acted as their mentor for their time within the organisation.
